

Ultimate Membership Offer — Terms and Conditions

The Ultimate Membership Offer is a limited-time membership promotion offered by Ashgrove Golf Club.

By applying for membership under this offer, applicants agree to these terms and conditions, the Club's Constitution, By-Laws, policies, rules of play, dress standards, competition conditions and any reasonable directions issued by Club management, the Board, Golf Operations staff or the Pro Shop.

1. Offer period

The Ultimate Membership Offer opens on **1 June 2026** and closes at **11:59pm on 31 August 2026**, unless extended, withdrawn or amended by Ashgrove Golf Club.

Ashgrove Golf Club reserves the right to end, extend or vary the offer at any time.

2. Membership period

Memberships purchased under this offer run from the date the membership application is accepted and payment is received, through to **31 August 2027**.

The phrase “**up to 15 months of golf**” reflects that the full benefit applies to members who join at the start of the offer period. Members who join later in the offer period will receive membership from their joining date through to 31 August 2027.

No further pro-rata discount applies under this offer.

3. Eligible membership categories

This offer applies only to the following golfing membership categories:

- Full Membership
- 6 Day Membership
- 5 Day Membership
- 9-Hole Flexi Membership

Intermediate Membership, Junior Membership, Social Membership, corporate arrangements and any other membership category are excluded from this offer unless Ashgrove Golf Club agrees otherwise in writing.

4. Promotional pricing

The promotional prices are:

- **Full Membership — \$1,599**
- **6 Day Membership — \$1,299**

- **5 Day Membership — \$1,149**
- **9-Hole Flexi Membership — \$929**

Prices include applicable Golf Australia, Golf Queensland, GolfLink, insurance and affiliation components where those components apply to the membership category.

Competition fees, cart hire, private lessons, guest green fees, food and beverage purchases, pro shop purchases and other incidental charges are not included unless expressly stated.

5. No nomination fee

The nomination fee, normally **\$200**, is waived for eligible applicants who join under this offer during the offer period.

The waived nomination fee has no cash value and cannot be transferred, refunded, credited or exchanged.

6. \$100 club credit

Eligible members who join under this offer will receive **\$100 club credit**.

The club credit may be used at the Club bar, restaurant or pro shop, subject to the systems and procedures in place at the time.

The \$100 club credit:

- is not redeemable for cash;
- is not transferable;
- cannot be used to pay membership subscriptions, competition fees, affiliation fees, PayAsYouGolf fees or account charges;
- must be used by **31 August 2027**;
- will not be refunded if unused;
- may take a reasonable period to be applied after the membership application and payment are processed.

7. Eligibility — new and lapsed golfing members

This offer is available only to:

- new golfing members of Ashgrove Golf Club; or
- former Ashgrove Golf Club golfing members who have **not held a financial golfing membership at Ashgrove Golf Club at any time since 1 September 2024**.

For clarity, a person is **not eligible** for this offer if they have held any financial Ashgrove Golf Club golfing membership from **1 September 2024 onwards**, including Full, 6 Day, 5 Day, Intermediate, 9-Hole Flexi or any other playing membership category.

A person who has only held Social Membership during that period may still be eligible, provided they have not held a financial golfing membership during the same period.

Ashgrove Golf Club may check past membership records, GolfLink records and internal account history to confirm eligibility.

If an applicant is found to be ineligible after applying, the Club may decline the application, reverse the promotional component of the offer, or require the applicant to pay the applicable standard membership fee.

8. Current members

Current financial golfing members of Ashgrove Golf Club are not eligible to transfer to this offer.

This offer cannot be used to replace, reduce, discount, refund or offset a current member's existing membership subscription.

9. Membership application and approval

Applications must be submitted through the Club's approved online membership application process, currently via MiClub, unless the Club agrees to another process.

Submitting an application and making payment does not automatically guarantee final approval of membership.

Membership applications remain subject to approval by Ashgrove Golf Club in accordance with the Club's Constitution, By-Laws and normal membership procedures.

The Club may accept, decline or seek further information in relation to any application.

10. Playing rights before formal approval

Once the application has been submitted, payment has been received and the Club has processed the application, the applicant may be granted interim playing rights pending formal approval.

Interim playing rights may be withdrawn if the application is declined or if the applicant breaches Club rules, policies or reasonable directions.

11. Category conditions

Each membership category carries its own playing rights, booking rights, competition access and restrictions.

Members are responsible for understanding the conditions attached to their selected membership category before applying.

In particular:

- 6 Day Members are not entitled to free golf or competition access on Saturdays.
- 5 Day Members are not entitled to free golf or competition access on Saturdays or Sundays.
- 9-Hole Flexi Members are limited to the access times, booking conditions and daily hole limits applying to that category.

Ashgrove Golf Club may update booking procedures, competition schedules, tee time access and operational arrangements from time to time.

12. Online bookings and check-in

Members must make online bookings for golf in accordance with Club procedures.

Members must check in with the Pro Shop before play and produce evidence of membership if requested.

Access to tee times is subject to availability, course conditions, competitions, events, maintenance, weather, safety requirements and operational needs.

13. Golf handicap and affiliation

Eligible golfing members will receive access to Golf Australia affiliation, GolfLink and an Australian handicap, subject to the rules and requirements of Golf Australia, Golf Queensland and the Club.

Handicap activation and transfer may take a reasonable period after the membership has been processed.

14. Instalment payments

Periodic payment options may be available through PayAsYouGolf or another approved provider.

Any instalment arrangement is subject to the terms, fees and approval requirements of the relevant payment provider.

The member remains responsible for ensuring all membership payments are made in full and on time.

If payments are not made as required, Ashgrove Golf Club may suspend playing rights, booking rights, competition access and other membership benefits until the matter is resolved.

15. Refunds and cancellations

Membership fees paid under this offer are generally non-refundable, except where required by law or where the Club determines otherwise in accordance with its Constitution, By-Laws or policies.

No refund or credit will be given for non-use of the course, lack of availability at preferred tee times, weather interruptions, temporary course closures, course works, personal circumstances, relocation, change of mind, or a member choosing not to use the membership.

Any request for cancellation or refund must be made in writing and will be assessed by the Club on its merits.

16. Course availability and operational changes

Ashgrove Golf Club will make reasonable efforts to provide access to the course in line with the relevant membership category.

However, golf course access may be affected by weather, maintenance, renovations, safety issues, competitions, events, public holidays, course works, temporary greens, temporary tees, altered routing or other operational requirements.

These changes do not entitle a member to a refund, credit or extension, except where required by law.

17. Member conduct

Members must behave respectfully towards staff, contractors, volunteers, other members, guests and visitors.

Members must comply with Club rules, golf etiquette, pace of play requirements, dress standards, responsible service of alcohol requirements, course care expectations and all reasonable directions issued by Club staff or officials.

The Club may suspend or terminate membership rights where a member breaches Club rules, fails to pay amounts owing, damages Club property, behaves inappropriately, or acts in a way that may bring the Club into disrepute.

18. Benefits are personal and non-transferable

Membership benefits, including playing rights, member discounts, booking access, competition access, the waived nomination fee and club credit, are personal to the member.

They cannot be sold, transferred, assigned, shared or exchanged.

19. Errors, omissions and changes

Ashgrove Golf Club will take reasonable care to ensure all promotional information is accurate.

If an error is made in pricing, inclusions, eligibility or other campaign material, the Club may correct the error and apply the correct terms.

The Club may make reasonable changes to these terms where required for operational, legal, administrative or governance reasons.

20. Privacy

Personal information collected as part of the application process will be handled in accordance with Ashgrove Golf Club's Privacy Policy.

Applicants must provide accurate and complete information. The Club may use applicant information to process the membership, confirm eligibility, communicate with the applicant, manage Club operations and meet legal or affiliation requirements.

21. Governing rules

These terms are to be read together with Ashgrove Golf Club's Constitution, By-Laws, policies and membership category conditions.

Where there is any inconsistency, the Club's Constitution and By-Laws prevail to the extent of the inconsistency.
